Are you an alumnus of Bryan or Yellow Springs High Schools who has celebrated your 50th Reunion or will be in 2025? We hope you are! Or maybe you started school in Yellow Springs but had to move away prior to graduation yet still have strong connections to your YS classmates and have deep roots in/for our hometown "village"?

In both cases, this special invitation is for you, and if interested, you too can become a part of this special group of 50th Reunion Alumni who have joined together for a noble cause dear to their hearts. These are folks who say, "We want to give back as a way of recognizing how much we received by growing up in our unique village of Yellow Springs."

This same generous spirit is what helped establish "The 50th Reunion Scholarship Fund" in 2016. Inspired by the Class of 1966's desire to "give back", the initiative came into existence soon after they celebrated their 50th Reunion. Now the 50th Reunion Scholarships are generously supported by those who have celebrated their 50th reunions, over 240 members of 16 graduating classes representing Bryan and Yellow Springs High Schools, from 1942 to 1974, with over 850 individual donations and a growing endowment of \$290,000. We continue our enthusiastic support of the scholarships and donate at least on an annual basis and many alumni give more often than once per year. And the Class of 1975 is primed to join us in the coming year.

The 50th Reunion Alumni partner with our local Yellow Springs Community Foundation who administers the fund and supports the committee, students, and the Schools through the scholarship process.

This Scholarship Fund is now making it possible for two graduating seniors every year to receive a scholarship. One scholarship is dedicated to a vocational tech student and the other is for a traditional college path student. A combination of an endowment distribution and donations accumulated in 2024 permits us this year (May 2025) to award one scholarship of \$5,000 for a vocational tech student, and one scholarship of \$10,000 for a traditional college path student. A committee from multiple classes will review the applications and make their recommendations: Ted Morgan '72 (lead), Anne Rauh '66, Bonnie Rothman '68, Vicki Arnett '69, Gwen Agna '70, Jim Grote '74, and John Gudgel '75 (YS School District).

Maybe you recall and continue to be aware of the priceless gift you received by growing up in a town that deeply cares about its children? A town with strong positive values where diversity and harmony were encouraged not just in the schools, but in the daily life of the Villagers.

The 50th Reunion Scholarships have become a legacy opportunity for anyone to give back to Yellow Springs.





Dylan Rainey, a class of 2019 recipient, sums up the Spirit of the 50th Reunion Scholarships when he said: "I will always treasure the town and the community, and it will always be what I identify most with. Before all, I am and always will be a "Yellow Springer." He gets "it" --- the "it" we've all known for a very long time!





